

Dear Parents,

October 2007

The first Sunday in October is World Communion Sunday. In the United Methodist Church, everyone is invited to join in communion. This includes children. We believe that God welcomes everyone and that no one should be excluded from His table if they want to partake of the sacrament. The decision of when your children should begin to participate in communion is entirely up to you. Some parents bring their children to communion at a very early age because they do not want them to feel left out. Other parents wait until confirmation because they want to make sure their children have a good understanding of the meaning behind the sacrament. There is no single right answer. When your child begins to ask questions about it though, that is the time to begin discussion. True understanding will develop over time with continual discussion. To facilitate these discussions, we are offering a communion self-study program for children ages 6-12. If you would like to participate with your child but are unable to attend the kickoff at the 10:45 service on 10/07/07, please let us know and we will get you the materials.
