



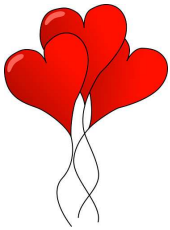

In honor of Valentine's Day, we are continuing to help build a Christian home with tips from "The Most Important Place on Earth." In this book, Robert Wolgemuth recommends giving your family daily vitamins...not the physical kind, but the spiritual kind. If you give your family a good dose of these five things, they will grow strong in your love.

Family Vitamins

1. **I Love You**—Love is a decision. Regardless of the circumstances, make sure your kids know you love them. Tell them at least once a day.
2. **I Need Your Love**—Put your utmost expectations into words
3. **I'm Sorry**—If you do something wrong, don't try to justify it or shift blame. Instead, make sure to apologize, say you were wrong, and ask for forgiveness.
4. **May I Help?**—Look for ways you can show your love through assistance, especially if someone is struggling
5. **Thank You**—An Attitude of Gratitude goes a long way. If you are grateful and appreciative, say it out loud!
